

## Govt. Institutes of Advanced Study in Education

#### Institutional History

Established in 1945 as Government Training College and inaugurated on 4<sup>th</sup> July by Sir George Boag who was the then Dewan of Cochin. It remained as an eminent teacher training institute to churn out teachers of excellence. It was at first affiliated to the University of Madras. The college was wound up as a measure of retrenchment with the integration of Travancore and Cochin in 1949.

It was re started in 1951 by affiliating it to Travancore University. After the establishment of Kerala University, the college was the got affiliation to the University of Calicut in 1968. The college has been elevated to the status of the Institute of Advanced Study in Education from 1993 with a view to conduct advanced courses in education, research programmes and to organize in-service training to the secondary and higher secondary school teachers. The B.Ed course still continues for both men and women in eight subjects as :

1. Malayalam

2. Sanskrit

3. Hindi

4. English

5. social science

6. Mathematics

7. Natural science

8. Physical science.

The institution is also running **M. Ed course** with an intake of 25 students. The college celebrated its Diamond Jubilee in 2006.
